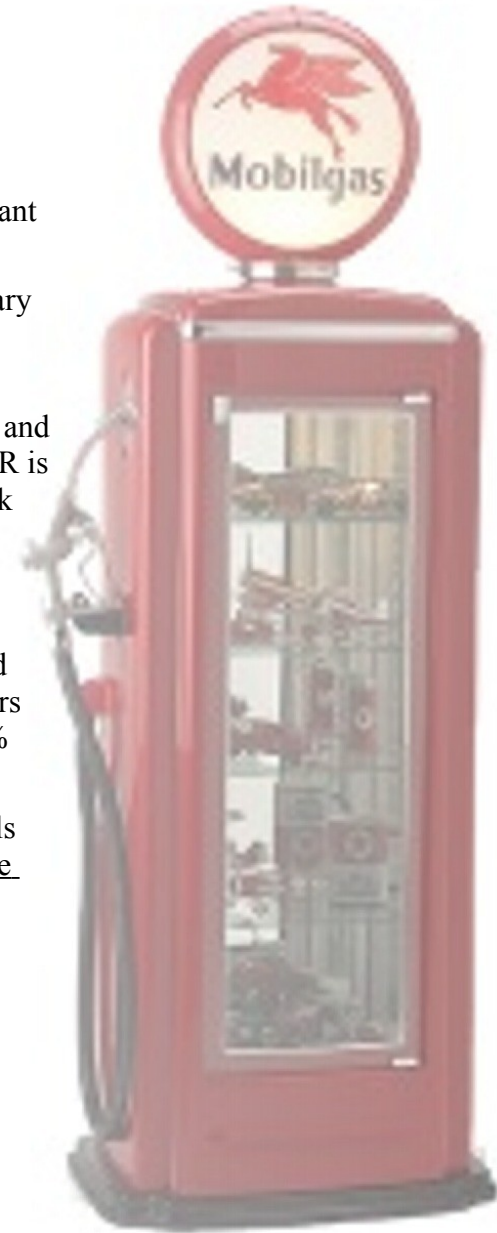
We are not commandoes, or a taxi service for addicts. We are professionals with an overarching goal: to do whatever needs doing to restore productive people to their careers.
